





Identify 3 things the law requires when marshalling vehicles Site to be organised to reduce chance of interaction between pedestrians and plant/vehicles There must be no other vehicles within 10 meters Extra long vehicles require 2 traffic marshalls Recognised hand signals must be used Activity must be risk assessed Marshalling can only take place in daylight What 3 things must you check about yourself before any marshalling activity You know where to position yourself That you have a driving licence You are wearing correct PPE You have a walkie talkie You have read the risk assessment What 2 things you must you check about the area around you before any 2 points marshalling activity That you are aware of any site hazards, e.g. slopes, crossings, blind bends, overheads, etc., That the HSE has approved it for vehicles You and the driver are aware of the route to be taken

That its not been raining in the last 24 hours
